Our goal in provision of housing is to ensure equitable access for urban Indigenous people on low incomes and support holistic wellbeing.

- We will review all information after your appointment and advise you of our decision.

Please note, we will endeavour to ensure we contact all those who submit an application, this will allow you to become connected with our team and for us to learn more about how we can assist you with your housing goals.

What if I am unsuccessful?

We currently have very limited housing available. We will continue to keep your information on file as our housing offerings expands other opportunities may come available. We are working hard to increase housing in our community and we are currently constructing 37 units of housing in Smithers. These homes will be available in early 2026. We are also developing an additional 35 units of housing in Houston, these homes will be available in 2027.
